

## Invitation to the High Level Panel on Water and Disasters at the 8<sup>th</sup> World Water Forum

14:30-16:00 on Monday, March 19, 2018 in Ulysses Guimarães Convention Center

The World Water Forum is the world's biggest water-related event and is organized by the World Water Council (WWC) every three years together with the respective host country and city. Brazil will be hosting the 8th edition of the World Water Forum. It will be the first time the event is held in the Southern Hemisphere.

His Imperial Highness the Crown Prince of Japan attended the 3<sup>rd</sup> World Water Forum organized in Kyoto, Shiga and Osaka in 2003 as its Honorary President and delivered a keynote lecture. Since then, His Imperial Highness has delivered keynote lectures at the 4<sup>th</sup> Forum in Mexico City and the 5<sup>th</sup> Forum in Istanbul. This time at the 8<sup>th</sup> Forum in Brasilia, His Imperial Highness will once again deliver the keynote lecture.

His Imperial Highness has been devotedly involved with the world water issues for more than 10 years and spoke about it as below at the press conference on the occasion of his birthday in 2017.

Water, the issues relating to which I have been involved in for approximately ten years, is something that can cause natural disasters through flooding or in other ways, while being also essential for human life. I think that "water" therefore provides a starting point from which I can contemplate ideas about stability, development and prosperity in people's lives and issues such as disaster risk reduction. Into the future I hope to continue pursuing my interest in "water" issues, as one means of wishing the happiness of the people of Japan and better lives for people in all regions of the world.<sup>1</sup>

We are pleased to announce that approximately 50 college/university students will be invited to the High Level Panel on Water and Disasters on March 19 at the 8<sup>th</sup> World Water Forum where His Imperial Highness will deliver a lecture. Hoping to be able to assist young people who are studying Japanese language and cultures in Brazil, as attending His Imperial Highness's lecture is very precious and valuable opportunity, we believe that this will further strengthen their scholarly interest and motivation.

Once you are selected, you will receive the details of the registration to the 8<sup>th</sup> World Water Forum and the One Day Pass for the Forum, which allows you to attend other sessions taking place on the same day as well as to visit the EXPO where the Japan Night reception will be organized in the evening on March 19.
